Join Camp Rosenbaum and the Portland Police Bureau for the 2019 Rosenbaum PPB Youth Camp!

Eligibility

Boys and girls, ages 8-14, who live in Multnomah, Washington, Clackamas and Clark County areas are eligible for camp. Camp is for kids who believe in good sportsmanship and who want to improve their skills. Space is limited to 500 campers. All children are expected to exhibit good behavior while at camp.

We are dedicated to ensuring that youth from throughout the metropolitan area are able to attend camp. To ensure equal access for youth throughout the area, camp is filled on a first come, first served basis. Payment must be received before placement can occur.

A minimum of 51% of youth must qualify for free or reduced lunch program, however all youth will receive lunch at camp. The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) and the State of Oregon prohibit discrimination in all USDA programs and activities on the basis of race, color, national origin, sex, religion, age or disability. USDA and the State of Oregon are equal opportunity providers and employers.

Cost

The charge to attend camp is \$35 per child. A reduced rate of \$20 is available for families who qualify for the free or reduced lunch program during the school year. If your child qualifies for free or reduced lunch, you must provide documentation. Please contact your school office, who can provide proof of qualification.

To pay by credit card, please register online at www.camprosenbaum.org/ppbyouthcamp. To pay with cash, check, or money order, complete the attached paper application, attach a copy of your free/reduced lunch form (if applicable) and mail with your payment to **Rosenbaum PPB Youth Camp, 449 NE Emerson, Portland OR 97211**. Please make checks payable to Camp Rosenbaum Fund.

Applications will be processed in the order received and notifications will be sent confirming activity choice and acceptance into camp. Make sure your home address, email address and phone number are correct.

Transportation

Rosenbaum PPB Youth Camp offers limited bus pick-up and drop-off service in the Portland area. Bus stops will be finalized in early June, after the majority of youth have been accepted into camp. There is no guarantee that all children will have bus stops near them. Please check www.camprosenbaum.org/ppbyouthcamp for the bus routes.

All children are expected to exhibit good behavior and show respect while riding buses. The Camp Director or a designee will address referrals from bus drivers according to their school bus discipline plan. Disruption or dangerous behavior may result in immediate suspension of school bus privileges. The Camp Director or a designee has the authority to issue suspension of a student from the bus, and to determine the length of the suspension.
