

## COVID Safety at Camp Rosenbaum 2021

Camp Rosenbaum is working on extensive changes and adjustments this year, so that we can **safely** return to providing a unique overnight camp experience for our community's low-income children.

### Reduced Numbers

We are reducing to a total of 100 campers, with only 6 or 7 in each bay. Each bay will include 2 counselors. Reduced numbers allow us to increase distancing throughout the week of camp. Each camper will have their own sleeping bunk, with at least 10 feet between beds, physically divided by lockers.

### Group Cohorts

Kids will only have interaction (though still distanced) with their Group / Bus Cohort of approximately 25. Once at camp, significant interaction will be further reduced to the 6 or 7 campers in their bay.

### Vaccinations

At this time, we estimate that close to half of our staff are already vaccinated. We are hopeful that by July, a significant number of our staff will have received vaccinations. We will anonymously collect staff vaccination data and share as requested.

### Testing and Screening

We're hoping testing technology continues to improve so we can utilize it at Camp. Campers will have health checks – including temperature checks – at least once a day. Anyone with symptoms will be isolated from other campers.

### Bus Safety

We will space campers on buses and limit time spent on buses. Buses will have increased ventilation, hand sanitizer available and masks required. This year we will only take field trips to outdoor locations – Sunset Beach and possibly Fort Clatsop.

### Masks Required

All staff and campers will wear masks throughout the entirety of the week. Masks can be removed during mealtime, and around bedtimes in bays. Campers will be encouraged to bring their own masks and additional cloth masks will be provided at Camp.

### Dining Safety

Campers and counselors will eat in the dining halls one group at a time, with increased distancing. We are exploring new meal service options – such as grab and go, or family style – to reduce the need for additional staff and reduce time spent in line or in the dining halls.

### Cleaning and Disinfecting

We will provide cleaning and disinfecting supplies to all areas, buses and activities. All communal spaces, such as buses, dining halls, bays and bathrooms, will be on a regular disinfecting plan.

### Activity Changes

All activities are proposing changes to increase distance, increase ventilation, and limit shared equipment or materials. Some activities may move outdoors. If an activity cannot make changes to operate safely, it may be cancelled for this year.

### Medical Plan

As always, we will have a team of six medical professionals on staff to provide any medical care to campers. Our medical team will create a protocol for addressing any camper or staff member with symptoms, to ensure the safety of everyone at camp.
