

Survey Says Game Show Basics

Facing Off

Each question starts off with one team member from each team facing off to be the first answer to the question. The contestant who buzzes in first gets to provide the first answer. If that answer is the No. 1 survey response, his or her team gets control of the question. If not, the opposing contestant gets to try and provide a higher-ranking response to earn control for his or her family.

Virtual Survey Says

The virtual version of Survey Says is played a little differently than the live show you have seen on TV. Once a team has claimed the question, team members will start providing answers one at a time. Team members are not permitted to consult with one another during this part of the game.

The Buzzer

When a person does not provide an answer on the board, the team gets an "X" and the question moves to the other team. If the second team answers everything correctly, they win the question and the points! However, if they miss and get an "X", the question bounces back to the first team.

How to Win

Gameplay continues until either team has received three "X's" or completed the question. If a team does get three "X's", the opposing team wins. Each game round will have a single question in a tournament-style event. Teams who win their round will advance to the next and will continue competing until a champion is crowned.
