Q. What time should I drop off my child at Parkrose High School? What time should I pick them up?

A. Please plan to drop off your child in the parking lot of Parkrose High School around 8:45am. Keep in mind that before this time we are busy preparing for the day's activities and we do not have staff on site to supervise children. Children should be picked up promptly at 3:00pm. The Rosenbaum PPB Youth Camp does not offer after-camp childcare.

Q. Are there transportation options?

A. We have four bus routes with pick-up / drop-off locations throughout the area. Please check our website (www.camprosenbaum.org/ppbyouthcamp) on June 1 for the 2022 Bus Schedule. Children do not need to be signed up for the bus stops – we will pick up whichever children are at the stop when we arrive. Please be sure to arrive at the bus stop five minutes before the scheduled stop time. If you're meeting your child at the drop-off, please arrive ten minutes before the scheduled time (times are estimates and may change depending on traffic conditions).

Children will be responsible for knowing which bus they are riding and which stop is theirs in the afternoon. If your child is not old enough to manage these transportation plans, please make other arrangements to drop off and pick up your child at camp.

Q. What will my camper's day look like?

A. We will start each day at 9:00am with a morning assembly before campers break up into their assigned activities. Lunch is served to all campers between 11:30am and 12:00pm. Activities resume after lunch until the day ends at 3:00pm. Before dismissal on Friday, we'll do a group photo and a gathering of the entire camp to recognize everyone's participation.

Q. What do I need to send with my camper?

A. Your camper should wear appropriate clothing and shoes for their assigned activity. All gear and equipment for their activities (such as gloves, balls, racquets, etc) is provided by the camp.

You do not need to send a lunch or snacks with your camper unless your child has dietary restrictions. If your child has special dietary needs or allergen restrictions, please send a lunch with your camper.

Q. Should I send medications?

A. We have paramedics on site to administer first aid, but we are not able to administer daily medications to children. Please plan to give your child their medication before or after they arrive at camp.
